Pastor's Notes

Advancing God's Love and Justice

Greetings!

Phase 3 is coming! Will the church begin to open up? What will the new normal look like? The Council is actively researching and discussing what this change might mean for First Congregational Naperville.

We're basing our decisions on science, not on the calendar, and looking at advice from the state, from the Illinois Conference of the UCC, and several other resources. We also are keeping as a basic framework, our Christian conviction that we need to take care of each other. As ever - just because we can do something, doesn't always mean we should do it. So with that in mind, please heed the following.

Church staff may begin to return to work in the building.

- Please do not "drop in." Some of our staff have medical conditions that make them more vulnerable, and we want to protect them (and you) as best we can. All visits to the church building should be pre-arranged. You will be required to wear masks and maintain social distance.
- Please keep your visit as short as possible, and limit the number of rooms you visit (including the restroom - if you can wait until you get home, please do).
- Groups under 10 are technically allowed, however, if your meeting/gathering has been taking place virtually, please continue this practice in order to keep everyone safe.

Worship has begun to include pre-recorded services, and will include some live-

from-the-sanctuary services this summer. Live-from-the-sanctuary may include a

few more people than we've seen so far, e.g. liturgists, childrens time leaders, and musicians who are willing to do it. Importantly, we need to celebrate the changes we've already made! We have continued to

have joyful Sunday services. (Especially Youth Sunday!) We have begun offering Zoom Sunday School and Coffee Hour. Our ministries have maintained their important work, from a safe distance. We have found new, creative ways of keeping our faith alive! These are very early days of re-opening. There are many, many other issues and concerns

to consider. The virus is still circulating, and some of us are still more vulnerable than others. So even though we're taking some baby steps toward normal, if your church business or activity can be done over phone/email/snail mail, please do so. If you feel you have to come in person, please call ahead before visiting the church building, remember your mask, and remain safely distant. Sadly, there is no quick return to "regular" Sunday mornings, but we will find ways to

connect one way or another. Your Council and church staff are continuing to find new ways to connect and keep our faith journey alive! We will continue to look at the data, and base our decisions on what is safe for everyone!


pantry for 18 to 24 months -- and general help on food safety for picnics. It's available as a website and also an app. Remember, it's very green NOT to waste food.


